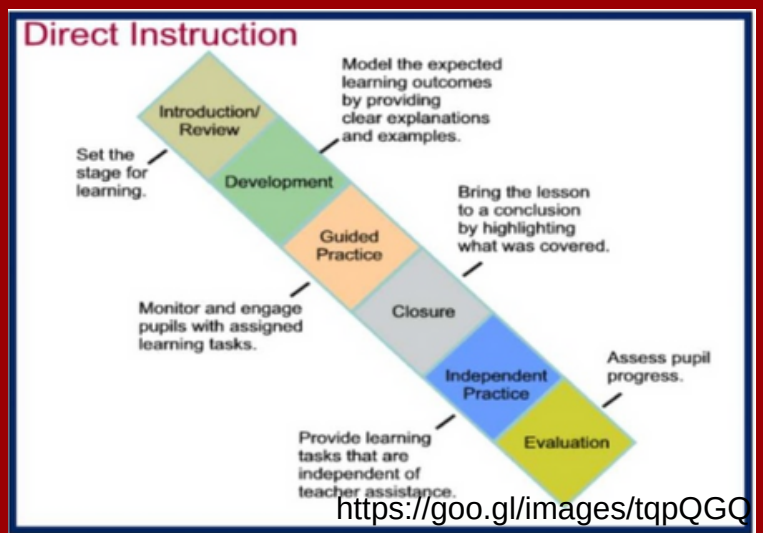


DIRECT INSTRUCTION WITH FEEDBACK

COMBINE STRATEGIES FOR STUDENT SUCCESS

Direction instruction is the explicit teaching of a sequenced curriculum of knowledge and skills, with cumulative practice and feedback that informs of one student progress.



Feedback is used to clarify, inform and guide one in understanding the knowledge or skills needed to meet a goal or target.

“Feed-up ensures that students understand the purpose of the assignment, task, or lesson, including how they will be assessed.

Feedback provides students with information about their successes and needs.

Feed-forward guides student learning based on performance data. All three are required if students are to learn at high levels.”

STRATEGIES ENHANCING DIRECT INSTRUCTION

Curriculum and assessments aligned to standards and skills

Share the purpose, learning goals and an outline of direct instruction

Metacognition modeled by teacher, practiced by student

Flipped, blended or hybrid instruction

Modeling or demonstration

Targeted interventions based on feedback

Conference and digital audio feedback

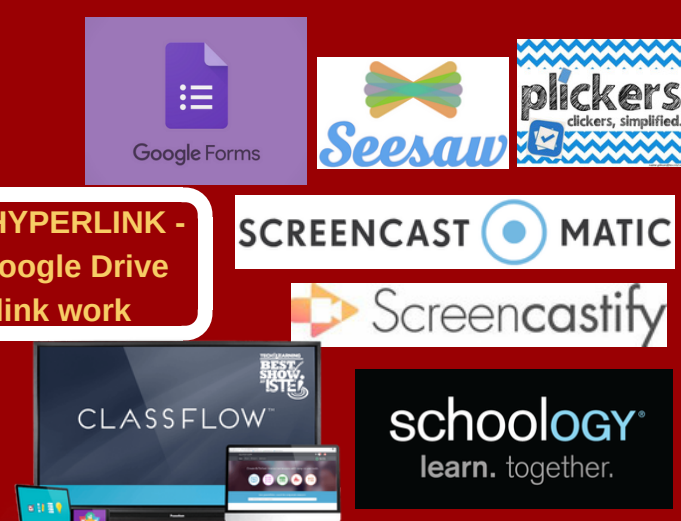


Feedback = How did your student do? + How could they do better?
